In each conference multiple sessions are held for each committee and the solutions put forth by the delegates are materialized into structured resolutions to be voted upon by the respective committee.

IITBHU Model United Nations is a well-known Internationally recognized, one of the India's premier MUN conference. It has undergone stellar growth over its incredible journey since 2012, attracting about 3700+ delegates over its 10 incredible editions. 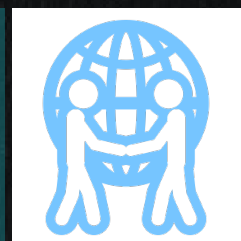

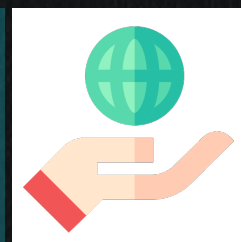
